MEMSA will be conducting examiner workshops for the purpose of training EMTs and Paramedics to be an examiner at the Missouri State & National Registry practical exams.

Requirements:

EMT Examiner

- You must be licensed and working for two years in the EMS field at the EMT level or higher.

Paramedic Examiner

- You must be licensed and working for two years in the EMS field at the Paramedic level or higher.

and

1. You must have teaching experience as a primary instructor, part-time faculty or lab assistant with an accredited training entity.
2. Current PHTLS or ITLS (BTLs) certification, PALS or PEPP certification, and ACLS certification for those wishing to test at the paramedic level examinations are required in order for you to serve as an examiner in specific stations.

Cost: \$25.00.

Attendance is **mandatory** for all individuals who would like to serve as a practical test station examiner in the State of Missouri.

Classes are from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. with one hour for lunch.
