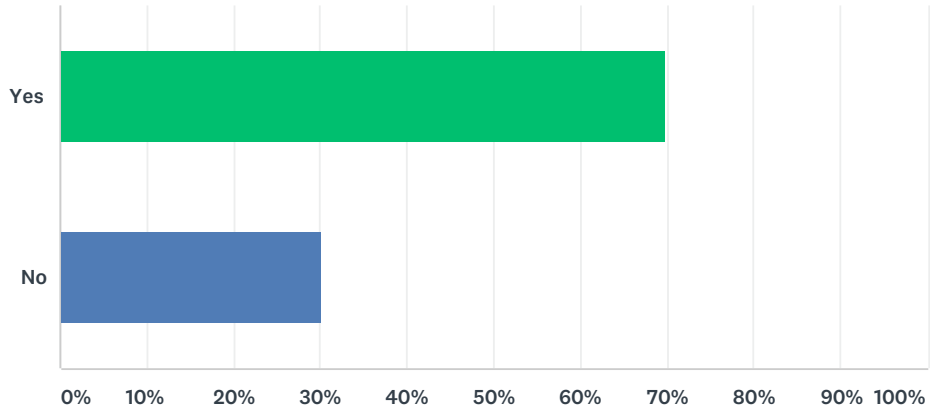


Tax Rate Cap Increase

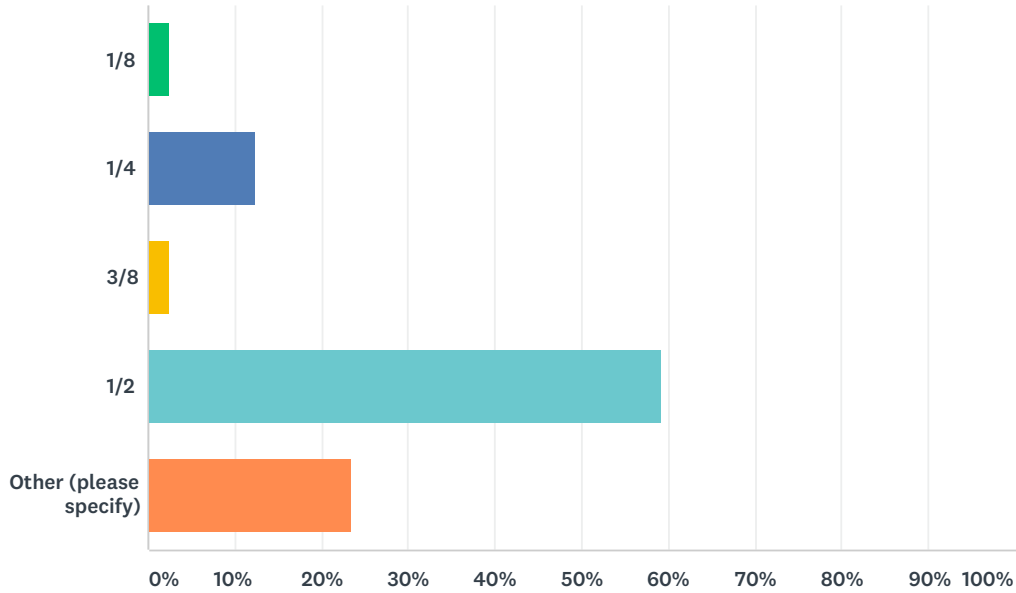

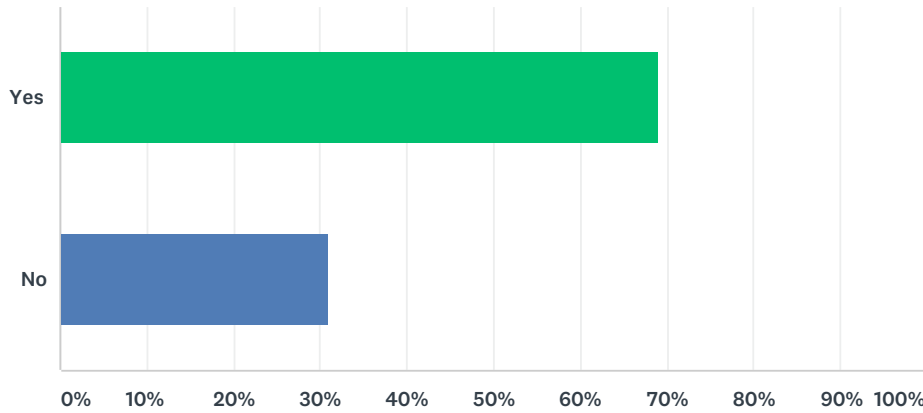

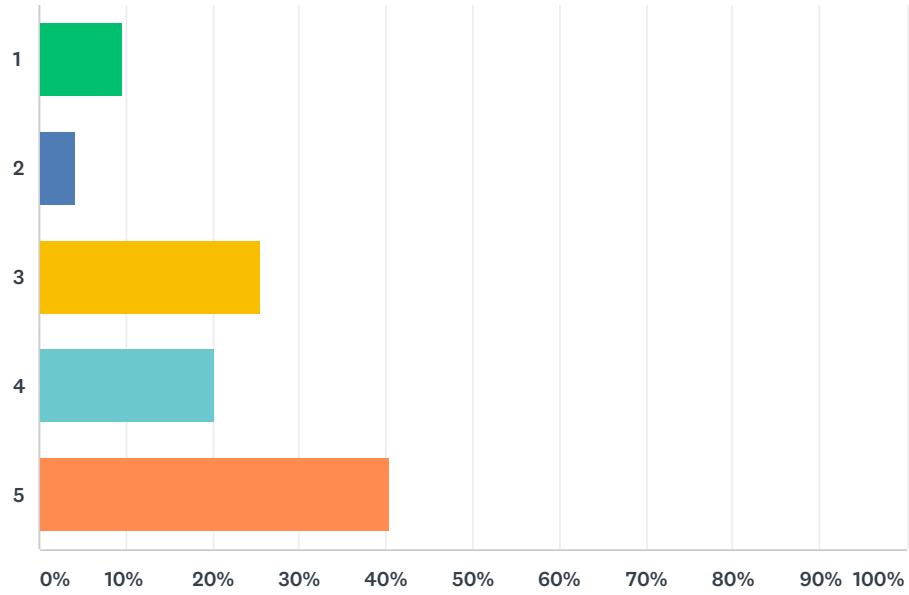
